She has special interest in the clinical intervention and research on dementia, delirium, elderly depression and issue related to mental capacity.

Dr. Rhoda Yuen, Ph.D. has extensive experience in providing psycho-spiritual care as a counseling psychologist to terminal patients. In the past 20 years, she regularly conducted professional training courses on counseling older adults, dementia care, end-of-life care issues and reflective workshops for health care professionals working in Hospital Authority, NGOs and the private sectors. She was the consulting psychologist for the Palliative Care in Residential Care Homes for the Elderly Pilot Project and Jockey Club Home for Hospice.

She is now in private practice and continues to be actively involved in palliative care and communication skills training.
