Ms Chiang received her Bachelor degree in Pharmacy, a Master Degree in Health Administration and being Fellow members of both the Hong Kong and Australian College of Health Service Executives. She has gained a wealth of experience working in the Hospital Authority of Hong Kong. She is the first to introduce dispensing automation technologies into the pharmacies as far back as in the early 1990s to relieve the manual dispensing tasks. She extended her influence beyond pharmacies when she helped to develop and implement the Medication Order Entry system for use by clinicians for prescribing for the out-patient clinic patients. She enhanced the safety in both the electronic prescribing and dispensing systems by working with external vendors to interface these systems to clinical intelligence knowledge database for clinical decision support features. At the present moment, Miss Chiang is concentrating her focus in working in three areas, which included the development of the in-patient Medication Order Entry System, the Supply Chain Modernisation of the pharmaceutical products and the Medication Terminology Table for the eHR project.

Mr. Franco Cheng is working as a pharmacist in Yan Chai Hospital and a part-time lecturer of the School of Pharmacy, Chinese University of Hong Kong. Mr. Cheng is a certified Specialist by the Board of Pharmaceutical Specialties in Pharmacotherapy. After completion of her pharmacy training, she had pursued post-doctoral training in Pharmacy Practice residency for one year at the Huntington Memorial Hospital in Pasadena, USA. Her specialty is in clinical pharmacy in particular to cardiovascular medicine. Dr. Lee is a certified Specialist by the Board of Pharmaceutical Specialties (US) in Pharmacotherapy and added qualification in cardiology pharmacotherapy. She is also the senior fellow of the United Kingdom Higher Education Academy.
