She joined the Department of Geriatrics of Ruttonjee Hospital since 1992, and worked in various subspecialties of the department; while she had relatively loaded experiences in community geriatric care of more than 15 years. She was appointed as the Nurse Consultant in Gerontology in Hong Kong East Cluster in 2015 and her clinical areas of special interest are geriatric frailty and dementia care.

Ms Tong Mei Hoi graduated as registered nurse from the Prince of Wales Hospital of Hong Kong in 1993. Ms Tong had completed the Diploma in Enterostomal Therapy Nursing and Postgraduate Diploma in Advance Nursing Practice (Enterostomal Therapy Nursing) in HKU SPACE in 2004 and 2006 respectively. Ms. Peggy CHENG is a registered nurse in general nursing, she started her nursing career in Geriatric specialty since graduation in 1987. His clinical areas of interest are in the management of Pressure Ulcers, Leg ulcers as well as the quality of life of ostomates.
