## Speakers profile:

### Dr. Vincent Tse

*Founder President of The Society for Life and Death Education.*

Dr. Tse is the Founder President of The Society for Life and Death Education. He was the consultant of the Clinical Oncology Department of Queen Elizabeth Hospital and was retired in 2000. Dr. Tse is an Honorary Advisor to the Hong Kong Pain Society and Hong Kong Society of Palliative Medicine. He has devoted more than 30 years to caring services for patients with end-stage cancer and their families, and pays special attention to their psychological and spiritual needs. After retirement, he is actively engaged in general knowledge courses in the universities and life and death education in HK.

### Ms. Margaret Suen

*Social work officer, Department of Medical Social Work, Caritas Medical Centre*

Ms Margaret Suen is currently the Cluster Coordinator on Medical Social Service in Kowloon West Cluster and Department Manager (MSS) in Caritas Medical Centre; a Central Committee (Palliative Care) member of Hospital Authority. She received her undergraduate training in the University of Windsor (Canada) in both social work and psychology, completed her master degree education in the University of New South Wales (Australia). With her clinical interest in palliative care, she completed the certificate training in Palliative Medicine from the University of Cardiff (UK) and in 2011, she became a Fellow in Thanatology. She participates in the teaching work as honorable lecturer and field placement supervisor in the Department of Social Work & Social Administration in Hong Kong University, and serves as the Advisory Committee member in the Department of Social Work in the Chinese University of Hong Kong. She was awarded the Hong Kong Outstanding Social Worker of the year in 2011.

### Dr. KC Tao

*Professor (Department of Philosophy, CUHK)*

Dr. KC Tao is a retired professor (Department of Philosophy, Chinese University of Hong Kong). He has been teaching general education for 30 years and is still actively participate in teaching on various topics related to philosophy, death and dying etc

### Ms. Faith Liu

*Nurse Consultant, (End- of- Life Care) The Hong Kong Association of Gerontology*

Ms. Faith Liu works as a Nurse Consultant (End-of-Life Care) in The Hong Kong Association of Gerontology. She is one of the pioneer of palliative care in Hong Kong and has rich experiences in the specialty. Her publication and research topics includes cancer pain; community palliative care in Hong Kong; preparing cancer patients to die at home; health problems encountered by dying patients receiving palliative home care and Advance Care Planning.

### Mr. Ivan Fung

*Social Worker, (End- of- Life Care) The Hong Kong Association of Gerontology*

Mr. Ivan Fung is a registered social worker. He received his Master of Social Work in the University of Hong Kong, and is granted the Fellow in Thanatology: Death, Dying & Bereavement (Association for Death Education and Counseling, USA). He has over 10 years' experience in cancer-related work, life and death education, end-of-life care and bereavement counseling. He is now a social worker at the Hong Kong Association of Gerontology, and responsible for the JCECC: End-of-Life Care in Residential Care Homes for the Elderly Project. He is also a facilitator of the Association's effort in promoting end-of-life care in the community.
